Highlights

In April, we moved from Zambrano to Santa Lucia. God heard and answered our prayers. We had the trucks we needed to move and the transition was smooth.

We have met some neighbors, some business owners, and even the Baptist pastor from Ireland and his Honduran wife—all here in Santa Lucia!

Santa Lucians are a little scared and stand-off-ish to white people. It will take some time for them to know we are sticking around and are safe.

In government, the person who is now in office (governor/mayor) promised jobs to people who are from Teguc. So, a bus load of people come in from Teguc. to work in Santa Lucia and a bus load of workers leave Santa Lucia go to

Teguc. to work.

* Pray for God to set someone in authority who will employ the people of Santa Lucia and that the people will be hardworking and full of integrity.

As far as religion, there is a Baptist church, Catholic church, Church of Christ, Adventist Church, Church of the Prophecy, and many Pentecostal churches.

* Pray God draws hearts to Himself, not religion.

Due to child trafficking, families are hesitant to send their children to evangelical programs.

* Pray that people will get to know and trust us and ministries that are safe.

In May, the end of the school year became very busy. First, Kjell created his first ever Discovery School Gala.

The art and literary work of students was compiled in its first publication *Chronicles of Discovery*. The black tie event (Gala) gave a platform to announce winners.

Second, the Discovery school choir sang on Channel 10 for a Mother's Day Special.

Third, Mikayla had a Spanish History exam to pass in 6th grade. The ceremony included the American Anthem sang by Mikayla and Sam (students from America), the Honduran anthem sang and conducted and then played on recorders, and a written and oral test (all in Spanish!).

Fourth, Mikayla had a graduation ceremony for 6th grade and Jeremiah for Kinder.

In June, after the events and graduations, it was time for summer. Through all of this, we have been able to have more play-dates for the kids and meet parents.

Even before classes were out, Kjell was approached to do tutoring in English. One will be his future student as well as Katarina's classmate. She needs to learn English (she knows Japanese and Spanish). They meet M-F, 9-11am. The other is Kjell's former student who needs help with writing on a college level. They meet T/Th, 1-3pm. I think they will add Friday.

For one week, we stayed in Zambrano with a team from Life Church (New Hampshire).



We worked on our project off and on during the week (sanding, priming, painting, washing windows, and building desks) for a future school.



We ministered many different times: Oasis de Amor Church, to teen moms, staff, and to residents of the Rehabilitation



Center. We had three Kidz Clubs (at Jimmy Hughes Ministries Children's home, and in the mountains of Las Botijas, Palenque, and El Espino). But it wasn't just sharing Jesus in words, they included the action of love.

They brought so much to give away too: pillows, sheets, towels, medicines, prizes, etc. that we had fun blessing people.

The team wrote a blog about their own experiences each day (<http://www.mylifechurch.blogspot.com/>). I detailed the days on our website too.

The team was a blessing, building relationships with and encouraging everyone they encountered (Hondurans, staff, other missionaries, each other, and us). What a display of the body of Christ!
