April was a busy, Discovery School month. I substitute taught for Kjell as he chaperoned a trip to Cayos Cochinos for beach clean up and helping an island school.

traditions we liked (walking down isle, placing of flowers, message, testimony, changing of shoes, placing of the tiara, toast, dance with the father) and made it our own. The theme was a Masquerade. The message was 'Remove the Mask' (by Kjell) and Katarina gave her testimony. It was a great time.

In June while the school year was coming to a close and I began to make preparations for our trip (lots of details), I offered to help a missionary with office work. I had a big bin of documents that needed to be scanned.
